**EARLY VOTING:** Early Voting for the **June 10, 2008, City of Oak Hill Municipal Election** will be held at the Davidson County Election Commission Office located at 800 2nd Avenue South, Nashville, Tennessee. The dates and hours for early voting are as follows:

**May 21, 2008 through June 5, 2008, Monday through Friday--8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

**The Polling Place on Election Day, June 10, 2008, is Our Savior Lutheran Church,  
(South Fellowship Hall) located at 5110 Franklin Pike, Nashville, Tennessee.  
The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Name and address changes or other registration record modifications must be made at or received by the Davidson County Election Commission by 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 5, 2008.



**EMERGENCY VOTING:** Persons entering a hospital between Wednesday, May 21, 2008, and the morning of June 10, 2008, and unable to vote in person on election day, should call the Office of the Davidson County Election Commission at (615) 862-8815 or (615) 862-8816 for emergency Absentee Voting Registrars to provide ballots and voting assistance. The call must be received at the Commission Office no later than 7:00 a.m. on June 10, 2008. (Election Day).

An eligible voter will be able to vote absentee by personal appearance at the Commission Office during the period of **June 6, 2008, to June 9, 2008** under the following circumstances:

- 1. Due to the death of a relative of a voter which would result in the voter's absence from Davidson County on Election Day**
- 2. If the voter receives a subpoena or service of process requiring the voter's presence on Election Day**

To vote as stated above, the voter shall show reasonable proof to the Administrator of Elections or his deputy. The above two categories are in addition to those persons or categories of persons otherwise authorized to vote absentee as set forth in T.C.A. 2-6-101 et. seq.
